A Message from the Director:

Dear MVCTC Wolfpack Members and Families,

I hope this communication finds you well. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Mon Valley CTC is planning 2021 reopening in conjunction with our sending school districts. Additionally, I am providing schedules, procedures, Frequently Asked Questions, and requirements for both “In-Person” and “Remote” learners.

In order to reopen, **and remain open**, a recommitment to health and safety on the behalf of our entire Wolfpack Family is required. Mon Valley CTC will be reopening to In-Person instruction beginning **January 19, 2021**. For health and safety reasons, Mon Valley CTC will be adhering strictly to Sending School proposed or tentative reopening schedules for In-Person attendance. The MVCTC reopening schedule reflects sending school local decisions and their respective reopening schedules. The MVCTC schedule is as follows and is subject to change as district plans evolve:

FAQ:

QUESTION	ANSWER
Can students attend the CTC prior to Sending School Reopening?	Yes, but only according to Sending School tentative Reopening Schedule. Families can pick up or drop off, Students may drive with Parent/Guardian permission, Districts may provide transportation prior to their reopening (procedures may vary by district).
Can students attend the CTC “In Person” on a Sending School’s scheduled “Remote” day?	Students must continue to adhere to Sending School Reopening Schedule and must attend the CTC “Remotely” on sending school remote days
Can students registered as Remote Learners at their sending district attend the CTC “In Person”	Students must be registered and attending In-Person at their sending school in order to attend the CTC “In Person”. Please contact your school’s Guidance Department to inquire if you are eligible to switch to “In Person”.
If my sending school is closed for reasons other than Covid-19 related (For Example: ACT 80), can I attend the CTC?	Yes, as long as it on your scheduled day of attendance according to your Sending School Reopening Schedule
If my sending school is closed for Covid-19 reasons, can I attend the CTC?	Due to safety concerns, students must follow Covid-19 protocols and attend CTC “Remotely” until sending school reopens.
