First of all, I would like to acknowledge the efforts of our families, students and staff as we "powered" through a difficult 20-21 school year. Last year taught us many lessons however the greatest lesson learned was that we can overcome any obstacles through working together! The 21-22 School year will have its own challenges as we are in a race against time to review, remediate, and accelerate learning in order to make up for disruptions to scheduling last year. This will continue to place emphasis on In-Person skill development. I have attached our In-Person grading categories for those returning from virtual instruction:

| GRADING CATEGORY | "IN PERSON" GRADING <br> What student is required to do: |
| :---: | :--- |
| 34\% <br> Daily/ Work Ethic Grade | - Student must be physically present in class in order to earn 10 points per day. <br> - Student readiness, participation, effort, and accuracy in daily assignments/projects will <br> be reflected in grade. |
| $\mathbf{3 3 \%}$ <br> Knowledge Grade | - Student accuracy in assignments is assessed and reflected in grade. <br> - Points vary based on size of assignment, quiz, test. |
| $\mathbf{3 3 \%} \%$ <br> Skill Grade | - Student accuracy in performing assigned tasks to specifications are assessed and <br> reflected in grade. |

Again, emphasis this year focuses on a "healthy sense of urgency" we all must have in order to maximize the time we have together. I know we can make this an amazing year!
