SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND MUTUAL RELEASE

This Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release (the "Agreement") is entered into on this 2nd day of November, 2023 by and between Intermediate Unit 1 Health Insurance Consortium Trust, ("IUC") and Mon Valley Career & Technology Center ("CTC").

RECITALS

- A. The IUC is an entity created by certain public school entities in Fayette County, Greene County, and Washington County that agreed to jointly cooperate to create a group health insurance trust fund;
- B. On June 16, 1992, the CTC became a subscribing member of the trust by executing a Trust Agreement with the IUC. A copy of the Trust Agreement is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit A;
- C. On February 17, 2014, the parties executed an Amendment to the Intermediate Unit 1 Health Insurance Consortium Trust Agreement. A copy of the Amendment to the Intermediate Unit 1 Health Insurance Consortium Trust Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit B;
- D. On October 25, 2018, the parties executed a Second Amendment to the Intermediate Unit 1 Health Insurance Consortium Trust Agreement. A copy of the Second Amendment to the Intermediate Unit 1 Health Insurance Consortium Trust Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit C;
- E. Pursuant to the Trust Agreement, a subscribing member may withdraw from the trust by giving written notice prior to March 31 of the year in which the member intends to withdraw with the withdrawal being effective as of June 30 of that same year;

- F. Pursuant to the Trust Agreement, upon withdrawal, a subscribing member shall be liable to the IUC to make payment for all obligations that accrued during the time of the member's participation or, in the alternative, provided that all obligations were paid, the member shall be entitled to reimbursement of its pro rata share of the trust based upon a formula set forth in the Trust Agreement;
 - G. Effective June 30, 2019, the CTC withdrew from the IUC;
- H. The underlying dispute ("the Dispute") arises from the Trust Agreement and the amendments thereto regarding whether the CTC is liable to the IUC for certain obligations that accrued during its time as a member of the trust or, in the alternative, whether the CTC has satisfied the obligations that accrued during its time as a member of the trust and is entitled to a reimbursement of its pro rata share of the trust;
- I. In relation to the Dispute, the IUC initiated an action against the CTC by filing a Petition to Appoint Arbitrator/Demand for Arbitration in the Court of Common Pleas of Washington County, Pennsylvania docketed as Case No. 2876-2023 G.D. ("the Litigation").
- J. The parties have denied any liability claimed or asserted in relation to the Dispute or the underlying Litigation.
- K. As set forth above, the parties now desire to globally resolve any and all issues related to the Dispute and Litigation on mutually agreeable terms, as set forth herein.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

In consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Neutral Settlement.</u> In settlement of the Dispute and Litigation, the parties have agreed that neither party will be liable to the other for any obligations, reimbursement, or any other type of payment pursuant to the Trust Agreement and any amendments thereto.
- 2. <u>Dismissal of Litigation.</u> Within thirty (30) calendar days following execution of this Agreement by both parties, the IUC shall file a Praecipe to Settle and Discontinue with Prejudice to dismiss the Litigation.
- 3. Mutual Release. Upon the mutual execution of this Agreement, the IUC and the CTC respectively, on behalf of their trustees, members, directors, officers, agents, employees, representatives, attorneys, heirs, beneficiaries, successors, predecessors, and assigns, and insurers, do hereby remise, release, and forever discharge each other, their trustees, members, directors, officers, agents, employees, representatives, attorneys, heirs, beneficiaries, successors, predecessors, and assigns, from any and all manner of actions and causes of actions, complaints, claims, counterclaims, suits, debts, liens, appeals, obligations, and demands whatever, of any kind or nature, whether known or unknown, which each party has, or may have had, from the beginning of time, arising out of or related in any manner to the Trust Agreement and amendments thereto, the Dispute, the Litigation, and any and all claims, claim for contribution and/or indemnity, crossclaims, counterclaims and demands whatsoever, including but not limited to, attorneys' fees and costs, that were asserted or could have been asserted

- pursuant to the Trust Agreement and the amendments thereto, the Dispute, or the Litigation.
- 4. Confidentiality. The parties acknowledge that the terms and conditions of this Agreement are to remain confidential, and may not be disclosed to anyone, by any manner or means, directly or indirectly, without the prior written consent of the other party except (a) in connection with enforcement of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, and/or (b) to each party's respective affiliates, attorneys, accountants, trustees, and thirdparty professionals working on behalf of such party who need to know such information for the purpose of performing their duties, and/or (c) as may be required law. Consent by either party to any disclosures shall not be deemed to be a waiver on the part of such party of any prohibition against any future disclosure.
- 5. <u>Integrated Agreement.</u> The parties acknowledge and agree that this Agreement is the entire agreement among them, and that there are no written or oral terms, agreements, representations, or understandings other than those contained in or referenced to in this Agreement. No course of prior dealing between the parties, no usage of the trade, and no parol or extrinsic evidence of any nature shall be used or be relevant to supplement, explain, or modify the terms herein, other than those documents specifically referenced herein.
- 6. <u>Compromise.</u> This Agreement constitutes a compromise settlement of disputed claims, the liability for which is expressly denied. Nothing in this Agreement constitutes or shall be construed as an admission of liability by any party.

- 7. <u>Full Authority.</u> Each individual executing this Agreement on behalf of the parties represent and warrant that he or she is duly authorized to execute and deliver this Agreement on behalf of said entity in accordance with its controlling documents, and, if so required, pursuant to a duly enacted authorization or resolution.
- 8. Mutual Agreement. The parties acknowledge and agree: (i) this Agreement was negotiated and agreed upon by both parties, and shall not be construed as if it had been prepared only by one party, but rather that it was mutually prepared by both parties; (ii) the parties were represented by competent counsel during the negotiation of this Agreement; (iii) the conditions, obligations, and remedies provided for in this Agreement were the result of sophisticated negotiations and sufficient consideration; and (iv) the conditions, obligations, and remedies provided in this Agreement shall not in any event be deemed unconscionable or unenforceable.
- 9. <u>Governing Law</u>. This Agreement shall be construed, enforced, and governed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 10. <u>Severance.</u> If any term or condition of this Agreement shall, at any time or to any extent, be deemed invalid or unenforceable by a court with competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of such term or condition other than those to which it is held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected, and each remaining term and condition of this Agreement shall be valid and enforced to the fullest extent permitted by Law.

11. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original and all of which shall constitute one document and the same agreement binding upon the parties, notwithstanding that all the parties are not signatories to the same counterpart.
